

1932 T&F CHAMPIONSHIP

The championship was held on the 16th of July at the Sports Ground, Guildford.

548 competitors from 21 counties took part.

The president of the Association was H.R.H. Duke of York and vice-presidents included the Duke of Sutherland, Lord Eustace Percy, the Countess of Iveagh and the Right Honourable David Lloyd George.

SALUTE / PRESENTATIONS

The salute was taken by Mr. William A. Harvey, the Mayor of Guildford.

The presentations were made by Sir Malcolm Campbell. Sir Malcolm set the water speed record 4 times and the land speed record 9 times during the 1920s and 1930s in various vehicles called *Bluebird*. His final water speed record was 174 mph in 1927 and his final land speed record was 301 mph in 1935.
